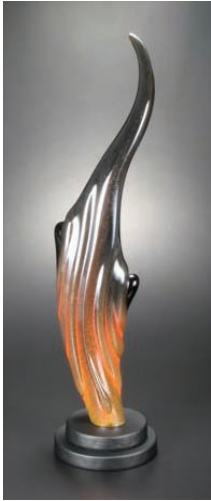


## Other Important Information

### Cancellation & Refund Policy

Enhance your glassblowing skills this summer in the idyllic setting of Jerpoint Glass Studio in Co. Kilkenny, the creative heart of Ireland. Don't miss this opportunity to develop your skills in the hot workshop, whilst enjoying the peaceful setting of the Irish countryside in the valley of the River Nore. Guest lecturer, Robert Levin will lead the workshop in a program that includes demonstrations, drawing and design time and practical exercises. The course will run during Kilkenny Arts Festival, the perfect time to visit one of the Irelands most beautiful medieval cities.

### About The Artist

#### Robert Levin

Rob Levin was born and raised in Baltimore and currently lives and works near Burnsville, NC. He was formerly the Resident Glass Artist at Penland School of Crafts, and has taught in many exotic places such as New Zealand, Rochester, Cleveland and Penland. He has exhibited widely in the US, Europe, Japan, and the former Soviet Union. His work is in numerous public and private collections, including the Corning Museum of Glass, the Museum of American Glass, the Contemporary Glass Museum in Madrid, the Mint Museum, the High Museum in Atlanta, and the Ebeltoft Glasmuseum in Denmark. He has received a Southern Arts Federation/NEA Visual Arts Fellowship, two North Carolina Arts Council Fellowships, and a North Carolina Arts Council Project Grant. ### About the Course

#### "Glass with an Attitude"

This class will deal with your natural ability with the glass to collaborate in making work that conveys a sense of movement; looking at how a curve here or some bit-work there can make a difference in your work. We will explore vessels and sculptural forms, with particular emphasis on developing a personal, more intuitive approach to glass-working. We will cover basic glassblowing skills, talk about running a studio & making your own colored glass. Also, there will be time allocated to do some drawing, and study our own movements as ways of making glass that has an attitude!



### About The Studio

At Jerpoint Glass Studio we have X space dedicated to the glassblowing workshops with a xxx furnace, three gloryholes (X x X) and 1 electric annealed (X x X). The course can accommodate 12 learners at full capacity.
